

David Roscoe Memorial Dimanche Tour

Sunday 19th May 2019

The event has no competitive element, and is intended as an opportunity for you to drive your 'Pride and Joy' through picturesque parts of Surrey and Hampshire. The total route distance is about 50 miles.

The start venue Blackbushe, Hampshire has plenty of parking space and the Cafe where signing on will take place. You are encouraged to make use of their facilities.

The day has been designed for two people; additional passengers are welcome and may be carried.

You will be given an easy to follow tulip road book to take you along our carefully designed meandering route to Lasham near Alton where we will have a coffee stop. Then onto Churt near Farnham for a late lunch.

Near the finish is the very popular Sculpture Park and you are encouraged to take a visit.

There are lots of beautiful views along the route with many places of interest, some of which will be described in the road book and some suitable stopping places will be indicated for you to spend a few minutes should you wish to.

About the Tour

The David Roscoe Memorial Tour is a new event in our calendar and remembers David who was one of the original founding members of Guildford Motor Club when the Club was established in 1953.

David died in October 2018. He was an active supporter of the Club through out the years.

The Tour has the support of his family and they have put up an award for the event.



Regulations

ORGANISATION

- 1 Guildford Motor Club will organise the "David Roscoe Memorial Dimanche Tour" , a Touring Assembly, on Sunday 19th May 2019.
- 2 The event is being held under a certificate of exemption issued by the Motor Sports Association Ltd., these Regulations & any written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.
- 3 The MSA Certificate of Exemption Permit for the event is: 112357

ELIGIBILITY

- 4 The event is open to cars.
- 5 All cars must hold a V5 Registration Document, be taxed and have a valid MOT certificate, where applicable. Cars must not display any advertising, **unless** specifically agreed with the organisers, or carry any competition numbers on the doors.
- 6 Any person may enter the event, **no Club membership is required.**
- 7 All drivers may have to produce a valid driving licence for the car being driven. A Competition Licence is **not** required.

ENTRIES

- 8 Entries open on the publication of these Regulations, and close finally at noon on Saturday 11th May. All entries must be made on the official entry form and be accompanied by the entry fee of **£10**. Each entry will be acknowledged by e-mail. Final Instructions, including an Entry List and directions to the Start, will be emailed during the week prior to the event.
- 9 The entry fee includes one Road book.

- 11 The maximum number of cars on the event is **20**. The minimum is **10**. Should this minimum figure not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event and the full entry fees will be refunded. Entries will be selected in order of receipt, the running order being decided by the organisers.

ROUTE

- 12 The event will start from the The Bushe Café, Blackbushe Airport, Blackwater. Camberley GU17 9LQ and will finish at The Bel & The Dragon Jumps Rd, Churt, Farnham GU10 2LD The route will cover approximately 50 miles in Surrey and Hampshire.
- 13 The route will be given in an easy to follow Road Book, which will be issued to entrants at the start of the event.
- 14 The first car will leave the **start at 10:00**. The others will leave at approximately one minute intervals.

DOCUMENTATION

- 16 Cars and Entrants must arrive at the start at least 40 minutes before their scheduled start time. The following documents must be available for inspection at signing on - Current vehicle MOT Certificate where applicable.

17 All entrants must ensure that they have adequate insurance to enter the event, and the entry form contains a declaration to this effect that the driver must sign. The event has no competitive element.

18 After documentation, entrants will be given their Road Book.
