The first pair of pictures were taken in 1967 at Prescott. They feature Bizzarrini 5300 GT Strada. This car does appear on the DVLA website, though listed with no MOT since 1983. However, it is recorded as a Iso Grifo and the car was registered in 1965. Around that time the Iso Griffo spilt with Bizzarrini who developed the mechanicals and went onto form his own business.
